

King of the Lake

Format and Sailing Instructions

- 1) The event will take place on Saturday 30th morning starting from 09:15 and finishing not later than 10:00; only the first skipper of each nation (as ranked at 23:59 of Friday 29th) can enter the King of the Lake Regatta.
- 2) The King of the Lake regatta and its scoring will not be used for the 31st Optimist Meeting scoring.
- 3) Taking part at King of the Lake Regatta is not mandatory; if the first sailor of a nation will not be available, the second one of the same nation will be invited and so on.
- 4) The invited sailors must collect at the Race Office a new sail with their national insignia. When they will come back ashore after the King of the Lake Regatta, they will have to give it back and use their own sails to continue racing in the 31st Optimist Meeting.
- 5) The King of the Lake Regatta will consist in no more than 2 races of 10 minutes each. A different duration will not be ground for redress. There will be no discards.
- 6) The races of the King of the Lake regatta will be **umpired** on the water and no protests will be allowed. This changes rule 60.1a
- 7) The course will be windward/leeward finishing astern of the RC boat.
- 8) The top three sailors will receive a **gift from Hannspree**.
