EVENT NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANISATION

The GC32 RIVA CUP 2019 Organising Authority (OA) will be the Fraglia Vela Riva in partnership with the GC32 Class Association.

2. RULES

The event is governed by the 'rules' as described in GC32 Racing Tour 2019 Notice of Race (NoR) rule 2.

3. ADVERTISING

- 3.1. World Sailing Regulation 20 Advertising Code, as modified by the GC32 Racing Tour 2019 Notice of Race of the 2019 Rule 13 and Addendum A shall apply.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1. The event is open to GC32's with a valid measurement certificate and registered with the GC32 International Class Association.
- 4.2. Boats must have a valid GC32 Tour Racing license.
- 4.3. All competitors shall comply with the World Sailing Eligibility Code, Regulation 19, and provide their World Sailing "sailor Identification number" and proof of membership to their Member National Authority (MNA).
- 4.4. All competitors competing for the Owner-driver trophy are required to register accordingly and are required to meet GC32 Racing Tour 2019 Notice of Race Rule 11.1.

5. ENTRY

- 5.1. Entries shall be made to the GC32 International Class Association (christian@gc32racing.com)

6. REGISTRATION

- 6.1. The Race Office will be at the Fraglia Vela Riva.
- 6.2. Each boat shall complete registration, including payment of all class and event fees, before 18:00 on Tuesday 10th September, including:
- 6.2.1. Completing the insurance declaration details (ENoR 18)
- 6.2.2. Crew weighing (Class Rule C2.2)
- 6.2.3. Completing the 2019 sail declaration form (Class Rule C11.2(b)).
- 6.2.4. Completing all required measurement checks/inspections
- 6.2.5. Provide parental consent for those participants under the age of 18 on 10th September 2019.

7. SCHEDULE

Tuesday 10 th September	09:00 – 18:00 Craning, measurement, sail declarations, crew registration and weighing at the Race Office at the Race Office of the Fraglia Vela Riva.
Wednesday 11 th September	10:00 Main event skippers briefing and safety briefing at the Fraglia Vela Riva. 13:00 Official practice races. 18:30 Press conference at Fraglia Vela Riva. 19:30 Opening ceremony / Aperitif at Fraglia Vela Riva.
Thursday 12 th and Friday 13 th September	10:00 Skippers briefing and safety briefing at the Fraglia Vela Riva. 13:00 First warning signal Thursday 12 th September. Further details of race schedule to be confirmed in Sailing Instructions.
Saturday 14 th September	Further details of race schedule to be confirmed in Sailing Instructions. 20.00 Regatta Dinner.

Sunday 15 th September	Further details of race schedule to be confirmed in Sailing Instructions. 17:00 Prize giving at the Fraglia Vela Riva. Craning of boats.
Monday 16 th September	Further craning of boats if needed, packing up and craning containers/trailers.
Tuesday 17 th September	08.00 – 12.00 Loading and departure containers (bump out).

- 7.1. Up to 20 races may be sailed.
- 7.2. It is intended that there will be no more than five races a day, however, additional races may be sailed on any day in order to achieve the schedule if weather or other reasons dictate. Further details of the schedule will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.3. No warning signal will be displayed after 15:30 on Sunday 15th September.
- 7.4. It is mandatory for skippers to attend all briefings, press conferences and prize giving as defined in the event schedule.

8. BOAT MEASUREMENT AND INSPECTIONS

- 8.1. Boats will be required to be complete inspections and sail measurement before 18:00 on Tuesday 10th September. All boats shall be made available accompanied by two owner's representatives during their inspection and sail measurements.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 9.1 Sailing Instructions will be available from the Race Office during registration and the GC32 Racing Tour event website by Tuesday 10th September.

10. SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- 10.1. All GC32's and their crews must comply with the safety equipment requirements as described in the GC32 Class Rules.
- 10.2. All crew members, including guests, will be required to attend a mandatory safety briefing before racing in the event.
- 10.3. All participating boats must comply with the legislation of their country.
- 10.4. All personnel involved in craning boats ashore are required to wear safety hard hats and hi-vis vests.

11. RACE AREA AND COURSES

- 11.1. Racing will take place on Lake Garda. Details of courses will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

12. SCORING

Scoring details for the event and series can be found in the GC32 Racing Tour Notice of Race 9, 10 and 11.

13. SUPPORT BOATS

- 13.1. Support boats must be registered during the registration period with the OA prior to being used as a support boat. An assigned berth will be provided for the support boat.
- 13.2. Support boats shall carry on board two people, and operate while on the water, a marine VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on International marine VHF channels and agree to assist the Race Committee if directed to do so.
- 13.3. Competitors shall have no communication with, and competing boats shall not be tied to, support boats after the Attention Signal for each race. Between races, support boats may approach, communicate with or transfer provisions or equipment to or from their support boats.
- 13.4. Support boats are obliged to help other teams or the OA if asked to do so.
- 13.5. Support boats crews will be required to attend a safety briefing to obtain permissions to get into the regulated sailing area.

14. BERTHING AND HAULING OUT

- 14.1. The OA will provide an assigned berth for each boat. Boats shall be berthed in their assigned mooring during the event at the Fraglia Vela Riva from 18:00 on Tuesday 10th September until the completion of the final race.
- 14.2. Boats shall not be hauled out during this time, except with and per the terms of prior written permission of the OA.

15. PRIZE GIVING AND TROPHIES

- 15.1.** The event main prize giving will be held on Sunday 15th September after racing.
- 15.2.** The overall winner, 2nd and 3rd placed will be awarded trophies.
- 15.3.** A trophy will be awarded to the highest placed Owner-driver.
- 15.4.** Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.

16. INSURANCE

- 16.1.** Each participating boat must hold third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least 3,000,000.00 Euros (or equivalent) per incident. All boats at the event registration are required to produce evidence of such insurance written in Italian or English clearly indicating the name of the sailor(s) or the sailing number(s) or the Class registry number(s) of the insured boat(s), including the starting date and ending date of the insurance and the euro/USD amount of the insurance.

OTHER INFORMATION:

A container / trailer park will be set up at Fraglia Vela Riva. Container / trailers shall arrive at the scheduled official arrival date. If dates or time of arrival are outside of those scheduled the Fraglia Vela Riva must be informed at least 2 weeks in advance. On arrival teams must check-in with the Fraglia Vela Riva to find out about their assigned container / trailer parking space.

Craning according to the schedule is covered by the GC32 Class Association / GC32 Event GmbH. Craning, storage and associated costs outside these dates and times has to be requested and confirmed by the Class Representative and Fraglia Vela Riva and will be invoiced to the teams.

Parking at the club and the event site is limited. Teams need to register with Fraglia Vela Riva for a maximum of two parking passes for the period of the event from the 6th until the 17th September 2019 midday.
