### 1. ORGANIZATION: Fraglia Vela Riva

The Frida Star regatta will take place in Riva del Garda on June 25, 26, and 27, 2026

### 2. RULES

The event will be governed By the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2025–2028

All sailors have to be members of the Star Class.

The Class Rules;

this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any subsequent Official Notices posted on the Official Notice Board. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the latter shall prevail, including any subsequent Official Notices. (Amendment to RRS 63.7)

Appendix "P" of the RRS (Special Procedures for Rule 42) shall be in force.

### 3. ADVERTISING

In accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20 (Advertising Code), the Regatta is classified as "unrestricted advertising." FIV-licensed competitors whose boats display individual advertising must present a valid FIV license upon completion of registration.

Competitors may be required to display a sticker on the bow, on both sides of the hull, featuring the logos of any sponsors provided by the organization.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

The Regatta is open to all boats in the STAR Class.

As per Point C.5 of the "PROTOCOL," registrations must be made exclusively via the website at: <https://www.fragliavelariva.it/> no later than June 10, 2026 (at least 3 days in advance).

By that date, crews must pay the registration fee of € 260,00 via PayPal or credit card through the website or by bank transfer to the Organizing Committee:

Receipt of the registration fee;

Tonnage certificate;

Liability insurance with minimum coverage as required by the FIV Regulations for Organized National Sports Activities in Italy 2025 (not required for those holding an FIV Plus membership card);

Competitors under the age of 18 must submit a registration form signed by a parent, guardian, or support person acting in accordance with Rule 3.1(b) and who, during the event, assumes responsibility for allowing the competitor to take to the water to race.

Registrations submitted in any other manner will not be accepted.

Participants who have successfully registered online and sent all required documentation in a single email to the address listed above will not need to submit any additional documentation. Furthermore, it will not be necessary to sign the release form, privacy policy consent, or the form transferring rights to photos and videos of the event.

## 5. INSURANCE

Each participating boat must be covered by valid liability insurance with a minimum coverage of 1,500,000.00 euros, in accordance with FIV 2020 regulations, or must hold an FIV Plus Card.

## 6. REGISTRATION FEE

The registration fee is € 260,00 and can be paid via PayPal or credit card on our website at the time of registration.

## 7. PROGRAM

A maximum of 7 races is scheduled, with a maximum of 3 races per day. The sailing event will be considered valid with four completed races.

#### 8. AWARDS CEREMONY:

Saturday, June 27, 2026, following the open-water races at the FVR headquarters.

9. RACES: The warning signal for the first race will be given at 1:00 p.m. on June 25, 2026.

For subsequent days, the time of the warning signal for the first race of the day will be posted on the Notice Board by 8:00 PM on the day prior to the day it takes effect. In the absence of a notice, the time from the previous day will apply.

On Saturday, June 27, no warning signal may be given after 4:00 p.m.

#### 10. RACE INSTRUCTIONS

The Race Instructions will be available on the website [www.fragliavelariva.it](http://www.fragliavelariva.it) starting at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 24.

#### 11. SUPPORT BOATS AND SUPPORT STAFF [NP]

11.1 All support staff, and in particular Coaches or Chaperones, must register by filling out the form available for download from the event's official website and sending it via email to [info@fragliavelariva.it](mailto:info@fragliavelariva.it) by June 20, 2026.

All coaches, chaperones, and support staff with a boat must complete the aforementioned registration form to obtain accreditation. This form must include details of their support vessel and a statement of acceptance of the "Rules for Coaches' and Instructors' Boats (BPS)" described in the Sailing Instructions. They must also be equipped with a portable VHF radio capable of operating on channels 16 and 72. The accredited coach will be authorized to use the registered boat during the event. An alleged violation of the BPS may be reported to the Protest Committee, which may convene a hearing and act in accordance with Rule 64.4 of the RRS.

## 12. SCORING

The “Minimum Score” system set forth in Appendix A2 of the RRS will be used.

When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat’s score will be equal to the score of all races sailed. When a total of 4 or more races have been completed, a boat’s score will be the sum of the scores from the races sailed, discarding the worst result.

For the results to be valid, a minimum of four valid races must be completed.

## 13. MEASUREMENT CHECKS

No preliminary measurement checks are scheduled. Competitors must race with boats, equipment, and sails that have been properly measured. No damaged sail or equipment may be replaced with another properly measured item without written authorization from the Technical Committee or the Race Committee if no Technical Committee has been appointed. Measurement checks may be conducted at any time at the discretion of the Technical Committee or the Race Committee, both at sea and on land.

## 14. AWARDS

Awards will be presented to the top 3 crews.

## 15. LIABILITY

In accordance with Fundamental Rule 4, participants in the Regatta referred to in this Notice of Race take part in it under their full and exclusive responsibility; Competitors and their Support Personnel are solely responsible for the decision to participate in or continue the Regatta. The Organizers, the Race Committee, the Jury, and all those assisting in the conduct of the event disclaim any and all

liability for damages that may be sustained by persons and/or property, whether on land or at sea, as a result of their participation in the Regatta referred to in this Notice.

It is the responsibility of the Competitors and their support personnel to decide, based on their own abilities, wind strength, sea conditions, weather forecasts, and all other factors that a good sailor must consider, whether to go out on the water and participate in the Regatta, to continue it, or to withdraw.

## 16. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The listening channel during the regatta will be: VHF Channel 72. A boat racing in the regatta must not transmit radio communications and must not receive communications that are not accessible to all other boats, except when communicating with the Race Committee. This provision also applies to the use of cell phones, smartphones, and tablets.



## 17. PHOTOGRAPHIC AND TELEVISION RIGHTS

Competitors grant the Organizing Body full rights and permission to publish and/or broadcast, through any medium, any photograph or video footage of people or boats during the event, including but not limited to television commercials and anything that may be used for its own editorial or advertising purposes or for printed materials.
